We, as parents and students, agree to abide by all state laws and regulations that are set forth by the school administration (and listed on the back of this application) concerning the operation of motor driven vehicles on the Madison County High School campus. **We understand that when any regulations are broken or when the driver is guilty of any un-safe practice which the school feels may be a danger to welfare of students, the parking permit can be revoked indefinitely. No refunds will be given for parking permits.**

All students parking on campus will be required to have this form on file. The locations of these lots are as follows:

Lot A –in front Freshman Academy Gym or between the Freshman Academy Gym and softball field (students parking in these areas will be given a gray parking decal). Parking spaces at the side and to the front of the gym will be reserved for students involved in fall extracurricular activities after school such as, football players, softball players, band members, girls' soccer players, etc....

Lot B- at sports complex (students parking in this area will be given a red parking decal). This lot is designated for students involved in spring sports (tennis, baseball, track, cheerleading, wrestling and boy's or girls' soccer.

Lot C- lower student parking lot (students in these areas will be given a black decal).

Parking decals (gray for Lot A, red for Lot B, black for Lot C) must be properly displayed either on the dash board or hanging from the rearview mirror with the decal number able to be seen from the front of the vehicle. **Failure to have a parking decal displayed or parking in an unauthorized area or space may result in the vehicle being towed at owner's expense and other consequences (in school suspension or out of school suspension). Lost decals must be replaced within 2 days at a cost of \$5. See Ms. Walker for replacement decals.**

PARKING/DRIVING REGULATIONS WHILE ON MCHS CAMPUS

1. In order to purchase a parking decal, a student must be of legal driving age, show proof of liability insurance, and have a valid Georgia driver's license. **Students are not to drive their vehicle on campus during the day until they have purchased a parking decal without administrative approval.**
2. A student must purchase a parking decal from Ms. Walker. No application will be accepted unless it is complete. The yearly cost for a permit is as follows: Seniors - \$20 Underclassmen - \$25
Checks may be made payable to Madison County High School. There is no charge for seniors who have earned a Platinum Card.
3. All vehicles must have decals displayed by Friday, September 18th (hanging from rearview mirror or visible on the dashboard). Failure to properly display parking decal and park in the assigned parking area can result in the loss of parking privileges, vehicle being towed, ISS and/or OSS.
4. Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not of right. School personnel will conduct routine patrols of student parking areas and inspections of student vehicles when on school property (which includes the sports complex). The interior and exterior of a student vehicle may be searched when a school authority has reason to believe that illegal or unauthorized drugs, alcohol, weapons, or other contraband is within or upon the vehicle. Such searches may be conducted without notice, without consent, and without a search warrant by school officials.
5. The maximum speed on campus and in any designated student parking lot will always be 10 MPH.
6. School buses and pedestrians ALWAYS HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY.
7. Do not cross over parking spaces to get from one thru way to another.
8. **Once at school, students are expected to leave their vehicles and not loiter in the parking lots.** Students are to use the appropriate crosswalks to move from parking lots to the school building. **Students are expected to leave campus by 3:30 PM at the end of the day unless they are involved in extra-curricular activities.**
9. **Students are not to drive behind the main building without appropriate faculty or staff permission.**
10. **Students are not permitted in the parking lots at any time during the school day without administrative or front office permission.**
11. Vehicles should be kept locked at all times as Madison County High School is not responsible for theft or vandalism to vehicles that are parked or driven on campus.
12. No flags may be flown on vehicles while on campus.
13. Students are not allowed to leave campus for any reason without proper permission from the front office.
14. Students who have permission to leave campus are not permitted to take with them other students who do not have proper permission to leave with said student. Students who do this are subject to the same consequences as if they were skipping.
15. At all times on campus and in student parking lots, passengers in trucks must ride in the cab; not in bed of truck.
16. Students are expected to have seat belts on before leaving the parking lot.
17. Music should not be played at such a level that it violates Georgia law.
18. If a student uses a different vehicle other than the one the permit is issued to, student must complete a new application but will not be required to pay another application fee.
19. Up to 30% of fees collected for parking lot permits can be used for senior recognition/ incentives.
20. If a student loses their parking decal for any reason, a replacement decal must be purchased for \$5 in order for that student to continue to park on campus. Lost decals must be replaced within 2 days. See Mrs. Sylvia Evans for replacement decals.
21. Students who violate any of these parking/driving regulations are subject to loss of driving/parking privileges on Madison County High School property and/or other disciplinary action including ISS/OSS.
22. Excessive skipping and/or tardies can result in loss of parking privileges (see Student Code of Conduct for more detail).
